## **GDPR Statement**

Asset Mapping Limited (AML) was formed in June 2012 and provides an Smart Building, Facilities Management and Asset Mapping service to its clients and via partners to enable real time monitoring of assets using a bespoke platform.

The range of data that AML monitor within the Asset Mapping platform is not considered to be personal or personal/sensitive under the definitions of the GDPR.

Asset Mapping Limited is a company registered in England and Wales, with company number 08101801.

## **How will Asset Mapping comply with the GDPR?**

AML's GDPR preparation started in June 2017 and as part of this process the company is reviewing (and updating where necessary) all internal processes, procedures, data systems and documentation to ensure the company is ready when GDPR comes into force in May 2018. The review included gaining certification to the following ISO standards with the accreditation body, BSI:

- ISO27001 Information Security
- ISO22301 Business Continuity
- ISO9001 Quality Management
- ISO55001 Asset Management

## **AML's GDPR Principles are:**

- Data is processed fairly and lawfully
- Data is processed only for specified and lawful purposes
- Processed data is adequate, relevant and not excessive
- Processed data is accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date
- Data is not kept longer than necessary
- Data is processed in accordance with an individual's consent and rights
- Data is kept secure
- Data is not transferred to countries outside of the European Economic Area ('EEA') without adequate protection

Asset Mapping Limited also processes personal data to comply with the eight principles of the UK Data Protection Act 1998.
